"Sunset Blvd" (Velocity) which is a great track is doing some blockbuster business at both Hot and mainstream radio and it's exciting to see this record move especially being that it is on an independent label. We hope to be getting together with Scott and his good pal Dave Harris soon.

Another independent artist that is having a field day is the Melvin Seals w/Dallas Colt single. Together these two are getting major attention from the release, "I'm Not Gonna Cry Anymore" (Rainman). Melvin was the musical arranger for Jerry Garcia for years, did his stint with the Grateful Dead, and was that hot keyboard player on Elvin Bishop's "Fooled Around and Fell In Love", a single that still gets played on AC radio to this day. You can expect to be hearing a lot more about him in the future.

"You Just Don't Get Me Do You" (Golden Records) from Jeannie Kendall is another independent single that is getting lots of attention at the format these days. She is an amazing artist that grew up in music. The Kendall's were a rather unique and very popular outfit in Country music, and its great to see that there are major fans of the group who now program AC radio.

Maroon 5 just keep getting hotter and hotter. Their "Sunday Morning" (Octone/J/RMG) is probably the best single for AC radio that they have in their musical arsenal. Rod Stewart is also getting back on track with a new single "Blue Moon" (J/RMG) which

pairs him up with Eric Clapton is getting a lot of love and attention this week from our reporters. Should chart soon.

On June 9th, Les Paul will be 90 years old. Steve Zuckerman, the Producer of the Global Entertainment and Media Summit had an idea to celebrate the birthday of one of his closest friends (Les Paul) who is the inventor of the solid body electric guitar and multi-track recording, and while his inventions changed the music industry forever, Les has remained humble for his entire life. "The idea hit me when he phoned me one night looking for Paul McCartney to call him for a project. I just felt this project should happen," Zuckerman said. By surrounding his idea with a team, including Bob Cutararella and Fran Cathart (also producing the record,) Zuckerman's idea took six and a half months of hard work and focus to become a reality. "We made calls to some of the most prestigious musicians in the business. It seemed like everyone wanted to be a part of the project."

Music director and programmer Billy Coble from KTRN (Pine Bluff, AR) is always on the top of his game when it comes to new and exciting AC40 music. This week he jumps on some records that have huge potential and some that have had some "most added" action as well. First on his list is the latest from Ingram Hill, "Will I Ever Make It Home" (Hollywood) a track that is having a huge opening week. Also on board for Billy and KTRN is "I Wanna Be" from Skye Moore (Southern Signal), Elton John's "Blue Moon" (Universal) and the latest from Melvin Seals w/Dallas Colt, "I'm Not Gonna Cry Anymore" (Rainman).
